- Answers participant's questions respectfully

- Has earned a bachelor or master degree in related field or working towards a bachelor or master degree with a minimum of 18 credit hours in a related field.
- Ability to teach the entire class series on specific subject area
- May have the ability to write the curriculum for the course.
- A commitment being reliable, responsible, and dependable, and fulfilling obligations
- Have the patience to teach and meet with participants who have different learning styles.
- Must have great communication, leadership, and organizational skills, be detail oriented.
- Volunteer at least 10-15 hours a week
